The Irvine Ranch Conservancy invited SHARE to participate in the construction of a new single track trail in Bommer Canyon. The Turtle Ridge Trail will be 2.1 miles of brand new natural surface trail that will connect the City of Irvine's Bommer Canyon trail system.
