Exciting news at AWCWP! There will be a trail work day to open a new trail in the Southwest portion of the park that will connect with Meadows Trail and create a new

loop. The new trail should be able to be ridden in both directions, have enough technical challenges to make it interesting and will have some of the best views in the park. The exact location is being kept under wraps until we get a little closer to the trail work day. Ranger Ed Bridges and staff believe that the new trail can be built in one trail work day. The date is Sunday, September 25th starting at 8:00

am and ending around noon. We will be able to drive to the trail work site. We will need around 40 or so volunteers to pull it off, with as many experienced trail workers and newbie's as possible. We hope to duplicate the success from last year that helped open the "Car Wreck" trail.
