With almost 50 volunteers and even more enthusiasm we marched up the trail and made Ed's goal a reality. We were able to cut a few new paths through the brush to bypass a few unsustainable parts of the trail. Though September isn't traditionally a great time to work the soil we were lucky enough to have a little moisture



from day before to allow us to work the trail into a rideable surface. All we needed was a bit of rain to help pack down some of the soft spots and the trail would be ready to ride (once we got the OK from the Park). Well that OK

came on October 16th and the trail was officially opened. The trail adds a great new loop in the park dropping down from the ridge about a mile from the top of Meadows Trail. Thanks for all that helped get this trail open.
